It will be the South Carolina Regional for the United States Scholastic Band Association (USSBA).

BAND CLASSIFICATION

ENTRY FEE AND DEADLINE

To register, please visit the www.yea.org/USSBA and click on to the **USSBA** on the left side and then click on **Schedules** at the top of the page. Scroll down to **October 6, 2007** and click on the **South Carolina Regional**. If this is your first time ever performing in a USSBA regional, then your entry fee of \$350 will be **waived**. If you should decide to be a full participant in the USSBA circuit, then this fee will allow you to compete in unlimited contests within the USSBA circuit. You must register online in order to compete.
