

Clinic Alto/Bari Sax Scales

(Scales can be played using any type of notation.)

The sheet music consists of ten staves of musical notation for Alto or Bari Saxophone. Each staff begins with a key signature and a measure number. The scales are:

- Bb scale**: Key signature of B-flat major (two flats), starting at measure 1.
- B scale**: Key signature of B major (one sharp), starting at measure 9.
