Performer Registration

We ask that all units stop at the registration tent to register and pick up your packets. All performers will be stamped upon arrival. Instructors/Directors & Chaperons will receive a wristband provided in your registration packet. If you need additional wristbands, you may purchase them at the registration tent.

Parking

Signs will be put up to show you the appropriate parking lot for equipment/trailer or spectator parking. Parking attendants will help assist with parking; please follow their instructions on where to park; do not hesitate if you have any questions or concerns with parking.

Admission

Admission: \$7.00 for adults, \$5.00 for students, and children 5 and under, free.

Props & Floors

There will be a designated hallway where your unit may store their tarp and props/equipment. Please keep all of these items in this designated hallway. Please be respectful to the props and equipment of other units. Clover High, the SCBDA, and the CHS Boosters are not responsible for lost or damaged items.

Dressing Rooms

Dressing Rooms will be located in the men's and women's locker rooms. Please see that your unit enters and exits in a timely fashion to allow time and space for all groups who need these rooms. Neither Clover High School nor the South Carolina Band Director's Association are responsible for any items lost, stolen, damaged or left unattended in the dressing rooms. Please throw away any trash as you leave the dressing areas to help keep our facilities clean.

First Aid

First Aid will be located outside of the performance gym, where the performers will exit, in case first aid will be needed during or after a performance.

Programs

Programs will be available for \$3. A lot of time and hard work went into putting these programs together, and will make a great keepsake for years to come!

Equipment

All equipment including tips of rifles, flags, and sabers must be taped or padded. This also includes any props that may be used, in order to prevent damage to the floor. Performance tarps are not considered proper padding. Your units' equipment will be checked prior to the performance, and your unit will be held responsible for any damage due to improper padding. Hard soled shoes must also be taped to prevent floor damage. All equipment carts must have clean and well-working wheels.

Sound Check

Sound checks can be done before the start of the competition, or during breaks that will be scheduled throughout the show. Please make sure to have a back up CD or tape in case we have difficulties with the one turned in at sound check. Make sure to have your show music in an appropriate case, to prevent damage to your tape or CD. ****ALL GUARD UNITS ARE TO BRING A COPY OF THEIR MUSIC THEY WILL BE USING AT THE COMPETITION. THE SOUND BOOTH WILL NOT HAVE A COPY FROM CWEA. MAKE SURE YOU BRING THIS WITH YOU. WE WILL HAVE NO WAY OF GETTING YOUR MUSIC IF YOU FORGET!****

Warm Up

In order to keep the contest running on time, we will follow a strict schedule. Please have your units arrive to warm up on time so that you may receive the full amount of time allotted. If a unit shows up late to warm up, they will only be given the amount of time left until they are scheduled to leave the warm up area. If a unit misses their entire warm up time, they will not be given an opportunity to enter the warm up rooms.

Hospitality

There will be two hospitality rooms available; one for judges and the other for directors and instructors.

Concessions

Concessions such as burgers, chips, fries, chicken tenders, nachos, candy, baked goods, etc. will be available for purchase in the cafeteria. Please support the CHS Band Boosters by purchasing concessions. Please throw all trash away before you exit the cafeteria to help keep the facility clean.

Photography

Please do not use flash photography as this may be a distraction and cause dangerous situations for units. Anyone caught using flash photography will be removed from the performance gym.

Retreat

Retreat will take place after the show is completed, and will be a **full retreat**. An announcement will be made when all units need to report to the **warm up gym** to be placed into performance order.

Judges Tapes

These tapes as well as show music will be available for pickup approximately 30 minutes after your units' performance.

Air Grams

Air grams will be available for \$1. Information written to a unit will be read prior to its announcement and any information we feel unsuitable to be read allowed will be thrown away. There will be no refunds for unread air grams.

Critique

A critique will be available for all units who may have another show or championship following the SCBDA State contest. **Critique will begin at the start of the awards ceremony.** A sign up sheet will be available throughout the day, outside of the critique room. Please be on time to your critiquing session.

Assistance

If you need any assistance throughout the day, volunteers may be found wearing an SCBDA State t-shirt with 'STAFF' written on the back. Please see any one of these volunteers for any help you may need.

Judges Area & Tabulation Table

Please stay away from these roped off areas and do not communicate with judges or tabulators while they are working. Tapes will be made available approximately 30 minutes after your performance. There will be a designated room for anyone who would like to listen to their tapes.

Performance Procedures



All performing units are asked to sit on the visitor's side of the gym after their performance to allow ample space for paying spectators.


Announcers Sheets
