## Repertoire Effect

- Does the repertoire display <u>creativity and imagination</u>?
- over time? Does the repertoire display opportunities for audience engagement through conceptual design compelling impact
- Does the repertoire display effective audio - visual coordination?
- Does the repertoire display logical and progressive the eye through the development of the program? **development** of one effect moment to the next and guide
- Does the repertoire provide opportunities for *nuance*, artistry and expression?
- Does the repertoire exhibit coordination and unity of wind and percussion elements?
- Does the repertoire display a variety of musical effects?
- How do each of these factors, collectively and individually, compare to each and all other units in the competition?

## Performance Effect

- How often does the ensemble <u>communicate the musical</u> intent?
- How effectively do the performers engage the audience commitment? through excellence, communication, and emotional
- How often do the performers *fulfill*, or *bring to life*, the musical expectations of the written program?
- How often do the performers <u>realize expressive qualities</u>?
- How often does the ensemble achieve <u>artistry</u>?
