1. Student Registration

- FOR <u>2019</u> ONLY, REGISTRATION CHECKS MAY BE TURNED IN TO ME UPON ARRIVAL AT THE CLINIC. IF YOU ARE ABLE TO MAIL A CHECK WITH YOUR REGISTRATION, **PLEASE DO SO**; HOWEVER, IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO GET A CHECK CUT IN TIME, BRING IT WITH YOU. **DO NOT** MAIL A CHECK AFTER THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE!!! IT COULD GET CROSSED IN THE MAIL AND YOUR STUDENTS WILL BE UNABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CLINIC. YOUR PAPER REGISTATION MUST STILL BE POSTMARKED BY **FEBRUARY 9TH**!! REMEMBER, IF I DO NOT HAVE YOUR REGISTRATION CHECK BY THE MORNING OF **FRIDAY 22ND**, YOUR STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CLINIC.
- Mail \$10.00 per student that you are registering to me no later than **Friday, February 8**. Send a check or money order with your registration. No personal checks from parents will be accepted. No purchase orders or cash will be accepted.
- Please find a way to speed up the process if your district cuts checks on a delayed basis. If you cannot get a school check that fast, then get a money order, write a personal check, or get a booster club check. Once a student has been registered, you must pay for them, even if they do not attend the clinic. No refunds will be given. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE SEATED UNTIL ALL REGISTRATION FEES HAVE BEEN PAID.
- Remember the difference between POSTMARKED AND POSTAGE. No later registrations will be accepted.
- Don't forget to register and pay for alternates as well.
- Be sure to include the registration form I have enclosed in this mailing. Please check "Will Not Attend" if no one from your school is attending. This will help me know that a valid registration is not lost in the mail.
- Please complete the chaperone form as well. This can be mailed to me with your registration or brought to me at the clinic.
- All students are to report to the auditorium for instructions. Seating of the bands will begin at 9:30AM. <u>ALTERNATES</u>
 <u>WILL REPLACE STUDENTS WHO HAVE EARNED A SEAT IN THE HONOR BANDS IF THEY ARE NOT</u>
 PRESENT AT 9:30AM.
- Remember that we will be starting a High School Alternate Band this year so encourage your students to register and attend.
 All-State students are eligible to participate in the MS and HS Alternate bands but they must register, pay the registration fee, and sit last chair in the band.

2. Cancellations

Should you have any students who need to cancel their participation after you send in the registration form, please send me their names via email (hwhite@lexington1.net). This will allow me to move alternates up in advance and make the beginning of our clinic run more smoothly.

3. Supervising Students

All Director's are reminded that SCBDA by-laws require that all students attending an SCBDA event must be chaperoned at <u>ALL TIMES</u>. This means that you must stay on site with your students. You should not leave for lunch, or anywhere else, unless you take your students with you. It is <u>unprofessional</u> and can be dangerous for you and your students should something go wrong.

4. Contact Information Form

All Directors are required to turn in the SCBDA Chaperone Contact Information Form. It should be filled out completely and signed by both you and an administrator from your school. Failure to provide this information will result in your student(s) being DENIED THE OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CLINIC. Registration fees will not be refunded for any schools/students that are denied or removed from the clinic.

5. Percussion Students

- All Battery/Mallet players are to bring their own snare drum, sticks and mallets. These students are responsible
 for the care, well-being and return of all accessory items provided. PERCUSSION STUDENTS WHO DO NOT
 BRING THE REQUIRED ITEMS ASKED OF THEM WILL NOT BE SEATED! THIS WILL BE
 CHECKED!
- All Battery/Mallet players should (at minimum) bring mallets for bells, xylophone (plastic and rubber), and marimba (yarn).
- All Timpani players should bring at least 3 sets of timpani mallets (legato, general, staccato) and a pitch pipe.

6. Attendance

Please keep in mind, and communicate the SCBDA policy concerning attendance at the clinic with students and parents.

A. Students registered and seated for the All-State and Region Clinic must attend all rehearsals in order to perform in the concert, unless excused by the chairman of the clinic **in advance**.

7. Medals and Patches

An awards order form is included in the email.

8. Plaques

Pep Wear will be in the lobby selling plaques the day of the concert for your students or parents to purchase.

9. Recordings

Order's for CD's and DVD's of the performing groups will be available at the clinic. The cost of the CD is \$20 and cost of the DVD is \$30. If you would like to purchase a CD/DVD combo it is \$45. The recordings are being produced by Ingram on Tracks from Lexington, SC.

10. Director's Meeting

During the Friday afternoon rehearsal, we will meet at a location yet to be determined at 4pm. In the past, this has been located in the Chorus Room; however, that room will be used for rehearsals. I will announce the meeting space at the morning announcements. Anything that is on your mind concerning improving the process, be prepared to bring it up at this time.
