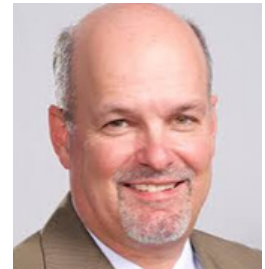

per Middle/high school band**

On Monday and Tuesday, each high school symphonic/concert band will play 1 or 2 of the festival selections his/her school ensemble will perform at Large group assessment before the panel of distinguished Music Educators. All bands will have 45 minutes total for playing and panel tips and assessments of the their groups. You may play one selection with the remaining time for comments or active interaction with your ensemble or 2 selections (remember you will only have 45 minutes) Use your time wisely ! We will have have 16 bands per day, each panelist will only listen to four bands per day. Because of interest implied we are asking you to please respond early with your non-refundable fees paid first to guarantee your bands space, this will be on a first come first served basis!

Wednesday February 26, is the enrichment band conducted by Ms. Edna Grace/ middle School and Dr. Jerry Gatch/High School. the cost will be 20 dollars per student you may nominate up to 10 of your top students, keeping in mind percussion students are required to be proficient on mallets, timpani, and snare. All of the other high school students will be able to handle 3/4 music that can be learned in one day with a performance the evening of February 26th. Middle school 2/3 that will also be played the same music. The difficulty level could possibly change change depending on your recommendations ! Most importantly they will be under the baton of 2 great clinicians who will reinforce what you have taught !

Also on Wednesday February 26, will be our signature enrichment clinics for Band Directors. The cost for this is \$100.00 per director and 25.00 for college students. Band directors who bring students to the enrichment bands will be admitted for half price! We know that we have some very informative sessions planned for your enrichment !
